PaperlinX's Burnie and Wesley Vale paper mills in Tasmania, Australia, have both achieved ISO 14001 Environmental Certification.

Established under the auspices of the International Organisation for Standardisation, ISO 14001 registration recognises organisations whose environmental management systems meet the comprehensive requirements of this internationally recognised standard. It addresses how to effectively manage the environmental aspects of an organisation's activities, products and services.

"This is an important step in our objective of all PaperlinX's operations achieving ISO 14001 standard," said Mr Ian Wightwick, Managing Director of PaperlinX. "Credit should be given to the teams at Burnie and Wesley Vale who have worked extremely hard to have both sites reach certification ahead of schedule," added Mr Wightwick. These mills produce around 210,000 tonnes of quality coated and uncoated fine papers for the Australian market.
